Policy 706 – Standardized Testing Policy

Preamble:

At LHCS, we believe that our curriculum and student performance need to be regularly evaluated to fulfill our vision statement.

Policy Statement:

- Classroom teachers are expected to administer the test to their class.
- Grades 3-8 write the Canadian Test of Basic Skills in October/November every other year, to make possible accurate comparisons.
- Administrators of the tests should familiarize themselves with the manual concerning the interpretation of results.
- Results of standardized test will be made public.
- Parents may receive a copy of their child's results if requested, along with a letter of explanation of the results.
- An acceptable standard for performance will be the 70th percentile rank.
- The results will be carefully studied by the staff to find the strengths and weaknesses of our curriculum.
